




What is in the complete set?

WAT10112/3	Hookah ashtray
WAT40115	Transparent drop-shape vase
WAT40119	Black hose
WAT40700	Hose mouthpiece
WAT40578	Clay bowl «Classic»
WAT50105	Charcoal tongs
WAT60991	Coal Watta 22mm, 24pcs
WAT50239	Grey hookah carrying bag
WAT50108	Disposable mouthpieces Watta

How to assemble?

<p>STEP 1:</p> <p>screw the downstem WAT10112/2 into the base WAT10112/1;</p>	
<p>STEP 2:</p> <p>unscrew the cone of the upper part of the shaft WAT10112/1, fit in the ashtray WAT10112/3 and screw the cone back;</p>	

<p>STEP 3:</p> <p>insert the assembled shaft into the vase WAT40115. If it is hard to insert the shaft into the vase, turn it clockwise;</p>	
<p>STEP 4:</p> <p>fit the hose WAT40119 in the base connector of the upper part of the shaft WAT10112/1;</p>	
<p>STEP 5:</p> <p>insert the mouthpiece WAT40700 into the hose WAT40119;</p>	
<p>STEP 6:</p> <p>Install the bowl WAT40578 onto the cone of the upper part of the shaft WAT10112/1. For silicone bowls, remove the grommets from the cone, as it is only required for clay bowls;</p>
